St. Cletus Day of Giving

On this Friday, April 26, we will be celebrating the feast of our parish, St. Cletus. Not much is known about Cletus. He was the third pope following St. Peter and St. Linus. Like St. Linus, Cletus was one of the first disciples of St. Peter in Rome. He was ordained a priest by St. Peter. He must have been quite a Christian to be named Pope which shows in his willingness to die for the church (he was martyred).

As you heard me talk about at different Masses, on the Feast of St. Cletus, the parish is going to have a special day of giving. The parish has had a major turnaround financially and the last thing that is holding us back is our capital expenses for this year. There are some major capital improvements that need to happen. The gym has two old HVACs that are 30 years-old (ten years past their lifetime) and need replacing. We need to put new lighting in the church. We have had to renovate some of the rectory from 1982, new paint and carpet in my suite. Next, the bathroom needs to be renovated (the old slip and fall tub needs to be removed). We need new concrete in front of the church. Thanks to parishioners we are receiving some major discounts on some of these projects. These are just some of the capital improvements that we need at the parish.

Our hope is to raise \$50,000. An anonymous donor has agreed to match that \$50,000 with another \$50,000. So if we raise \$50,000 we will have raised \$100,000. This day is an exciting day and we are planning on having a BBQ for the parish on that day thanks to the Men's Club and the PTO.

Please pray over and consider what you can give on that day. We are all called to make sacrifices for the body of Christ at St. Cletus. Remember who loved us first. There are two ways to pay. You can come up to the rectory on that day and donate. Please write on the check, "Day of Giving." Or you can give online at <a href="www.saintcletus.org">www.saintcletus.org</a>. Donations will also be accepted before and after the day of the event.

If you can, please join us for the BBQ to celebrate our parish namesake.


### Stroke Risk Screening

Ultrasound of the carotid artery looking for plaque or blocked arteries.



### Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm Screening

Ultrasound of the abdominal aorta looking for an aneurysm.



### Thyroid Screening †

Ultrasound looking for physical lesions such as nodules or cysts.



### Liver Screening

Ultrasound looking for physical lesions such as masses or tumors.



### Kidneys (2) Screening +

Ultrasound looking for physical lesions such as cysts, masses, and stones.



### Gallbladder Screening †

Ultrasound looking for physical lesions such as polyps, stones, and sludge.

- If you are taking medication, continue to take it.




