Bridge Bread Quarterly Report


The new year proved to continue to produce strong Bridge Bread sales. In January we had a sellout with a record-high in sales of \$846 which also included a record high donation of \$294!

Six-packs of cookies were introduced in February and seem to be popular. We ended up with \$41 of unsold products taken to Mt Carmel. We had a very, very generous parishioner donate \$200 which shattered the previous record-high sales of \$1054 which was sent to Bridge Bread. Our net donation was \$485-another record broken!!

With the increasing number of parishioners attending mass, more Bridge Bread items were ordered for March sales. It was another awesome sellout bringing in \$967 of which \$320.50 was a donation to Bridge Bread!

We appreciate your patronage and support. The smiles on your faces when you say, "keep the change" or those folded bills you slip us show God's love. It all adds up to a successful outcome for the bakers at Bridge Bread providing them with an income to make a better life for themselves and their families. We are truly blessed!

Birthright of St. Charles: \$855 from Christmas Card Sales; \$200 from the St. Cletus PSR Confirmation Class Baby Bottle challenge, March 2024. Birthright assists pregnant women with counseling, medical care, and items for mother and baby needs.

St. Martha's Hall: \$250 from St. Cletus School Baby Bottle Challenge, March 2024. St. Martha's Hall is a nationally accredited home providing emergency and confidential shelter for women and children who are victims of domestic violence in attempt to break the cycle of domestic violence.

Queen of Peace provides family-centered care for women with substance abuse, their families and at-risk youth through treatment, housing, prevention programs and education services in residential and outpatient setting.

This organization provides baby supplies, clothing and personal care needs for mothers and fathers, their babies and for pregnant women. Located in O'Fallon, MO.

Missouri Right to Life Coalition, \$50 annual membership in this organization which works for laws protecting the life of the unborn.


